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Further Information

Test data has shown that the zinc dialkyl dithiophosphate contained does not lead to a classification of the product as "Eye Irrit. 2". All concentrations are quoted as mass percentages for liquids and volume percentages for gases. Other substances which are not classified as dangerous are contained up to 100 %.
