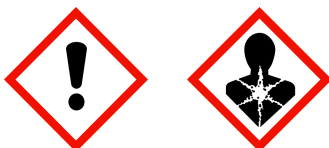

#### SECTION 4: First aid measures

##### 4.1. Description of first aid measures

###### General information

Keep people at a distance and stay on the windward side. Remove casualty to fresh air and keep warm and at rest.
